

DROID Bionic by Motorola Software Upgrade



Overview

For the DROID Bionic by Motorola, there are 2 convenient ways to download the software upgrade.

Here are a few hints to make the process quick and easy:

- It will take you approximately 10-15 minutes to download the software, depending on network conditions.
- Once you download the software, the next step is to install it onto the device. Installation should take up to 5-10 additional minutes. Keep in mind that during the installation you will be unable to make or receive calls, including emergency calls.

Note: The size for this software upgrade is 42.5 MB.

Over The Air (OTA) Software




There are two types of OTA software upgrades:

1. OTA User Initiated - Follow these instructions if you would like to manually search for an upgrade on your device.
2. OTA Server Initiated - Follow these instructions if you receive a notice on your device indicating that there is a software upgrade available.

OTA User Initiated

This process allows a user to navigate through the device options to seek updates.

1. From the Home screen, tap the **Menu Key** > tap **Settings** > **About phone** > **System Updates** > **Download**.




2. Once the software download is complete, tap **Install now**. Once installation is complete the device powers off and back on again to finalize the installation. You will see a confirmation on the home screen that your install was successful, tap **Ok**.



OTA Server Initiated


1. The software update package is downloaded to the phone in the background. You will be notified that a system update is available on your device. Tap **Download** to begin.

2. Once the download has complete, tap Install now. The device will power off then back on and show a progress bar and an installing icon. Once installation is complete the device powers off then back on finalizing the installation. You will see a confirmation on the home screen that your install was successful, tap **Ok**.



If the system update fails to install, you will get an error screen. However, this only means the software did not install properly. Remove and re-insert the battery and power the device back on. The device will power back on with original software and will prompt you once again to install the system update.
