Customization



Customize to your heart's content.

Your phone's Home screen is highly customizable and extends beyond the screen width, giving you plenty of space to add the information that matters most in your daily life and phone features that make communication quicker and easier. You have up to seven screens that extend to the left and right sides of your display as your Home screen, on which you can add elements such as widgets, program icons, shortcuts to information, and more.

Notifications Panel

Notifications let you know when an event has occurred that may require your attention such as voicemail, missed calls, text messages, Android Market download, calendar reminder, etc.

To View the Notification Panel:

Touch the status bar at the top of the screen and drag it down. Touch each notification to view the details. When you are done, touch the **Home Key** to return to the home screen or simply tap the bottom of the notification panel to send it back up.

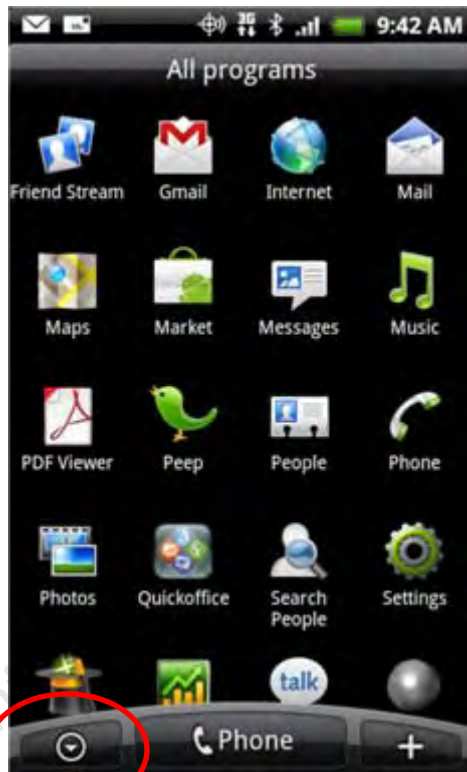

Touch Screen Gestures

There are several touch motions recognized by the device:

Touch – to select a menu item or open an application

Touch and hold – to grab an object that you want to move or open an option menu

Pinch: For some applications, like Albums or Browser, you can “pinch” the screen using 2 fingers (for example, thumb and index fingers) to zoom in or zoom out when viewing a picture or a webpage.

Drag – to move an object or scroll slowly on a list or web page

Flick – to scroll quickly on a list or web page (touch the screen again to stop the scrolling action)

Leap – pinch to jump between the 7 panels on your Home screen

Sleep Mode

Your display will go dark if untouched for a period of time. Press the **Power/Lock Key** to wake it up again.

From any screen, you can put your display back into sleep mode. Just press the **Power/Lock Key**. This will prevent false key presses as well as help you conserve battery life.

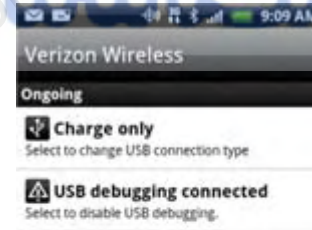

1. Connect the phone to your computer using the supplied USB cable. When the Connect to PC dialog box appears, tap Disk drive, and then tap Done.
2. On your computer, the connected phone is recognized as a removable disk. Navigate to this removable disk and open it.
3. Do one of the following:
 - Copy the files from the computer to the phone's storage card's root folder.
 - Copy the files from the phone's storage card to a folder in your computer or computer desktop.
5. After copying the files, unmount the removable disk (that is, the connected phone) as required by your computer's operating system to safely remove your phone.
6. Do one of the following:
 - Disconnect the phone from the computer.
 - If you want to keep the phone connected to the computer but want the phone to be able to access the storage card, open the Notifications panel, tap Disk drive, select an option except Disk drive, and then tap Done. See "Opening the Notifications panel" in this chapter to learn how to open the Notifications panel.

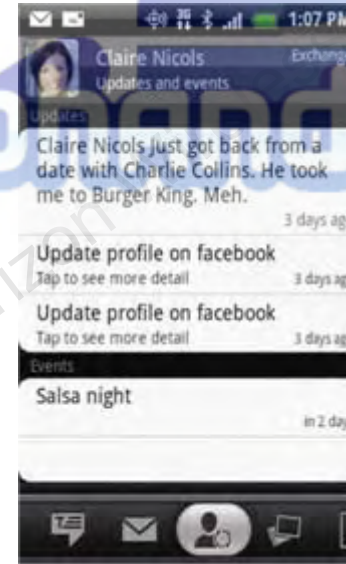

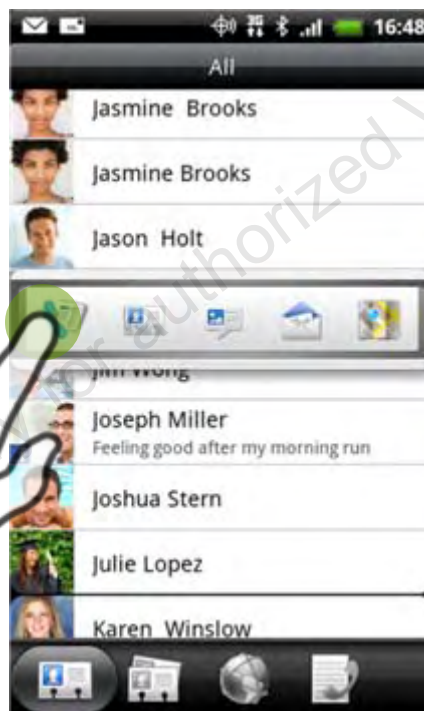

HTC Helpful Hints

Installing the battery

You need to remove the back cover before you can install the battery and storage card. Also, make sure to always turn off the power before installing or replacing the battery.

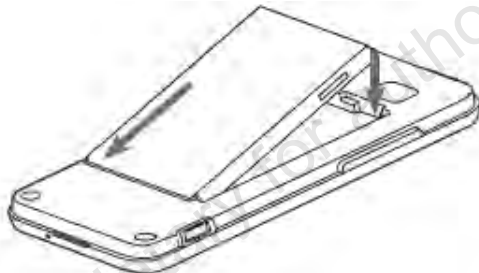
To remove the back cover

1. Make sure your phone is turned off.
2. Hold the phone securely with the front panel facing away from you.
3. Pull the cover open with your finger from the gap at the top of the phone.



To install the battery

1. Align the battery's exposed copper contacts with the battery connectors at the bottom part of the battery compartment.
2. Insert the contacts side of the battery first and then gently push the battery into place.
3. Replace the back cover.



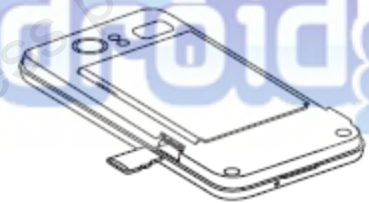
Removing the battery

Lift out the battery from the groove at the upper side of the battery compartment.

Installing a microSD (8GB pre-installed)

1. Remove the back cover.
2. Locate the microSD card slot on the lower left part of the exposed panel.
3. Insert the microSD card into the slot with its gold contacts facing down until it clicks into place.

Note To remove the microSD card, press it to eject it from the slot.

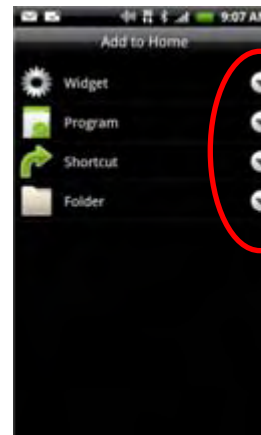

Helpful Hints – Getting Started and Keeping Going

Powering your wireless device on for the first time

It's important to fully charge the battery before turning on your wireless device.

1. Press the POWER button on top of the phone.
2. When you turn on your phone for the first time, follow the instructions on the screen to activate your device and set up the rest of the device through the HTC wizard including email, social networking and more.

Powering your wireless device off

1. Long press the POWER button on top of the phone for a couple of seconds.
2. Tap **Power Off** on the Quick List.

Checking the hardware / PRL / PRI Browser and ERI version(s) on your device

You can find the information easily by selecting the following path:

From the Home screen, Tap Menu > Settings > About Phone > Software Information
(PRL, PRI, Browser Version, ERI Version)

Manually Programming your device

1. Power on the device.
2. Select **Phone**. Press [#] [#] [P] [S] [T] (##778) [Call].
3. Select EDIT Mode and enter **SPC Code**. The default code is **000000**. Then press [OK].
4. The EPST is now displayed. Select **NAM SETTINGS** from the menu.
5. Select Desired field and enter the information.
6. Touch Menu and select Commit Modification.
7. Press [OK] to update items and reset the device. Device will reset.

OTA Instructions for your device

1. Perform the usual billing system activation procedure.
2. Power-up the phone and enter Star Code, ***228** [Send].
3. The following audio message will be heard: **"Welcome to Verizon Wireless' device programming . This call is airtime free. To program your phone, press 1. Update your roaming capabilities, 2, to switch devices and use your same mobile number, 3."**

Note: Programming will take up to 2 minutes. Should the programming exceed 45 seconds, the following audio message will be repeated at 25 second intervals: **"Please continue to hold. Your phone is being programmed."** You will hear an audio message once the phone has been successfully programmed.

Helpful Hints – Battery Life & Phone Calls

Maximizing Battery life

Changing device settings can preserve battery life.

Turn off Bluetooth when not in use:

- **Menu> Settings > Wireless & networks** and tap **Bluetooth**.

Adjust the **Backlight** settings to lower brightness, change screen time out

settings, and adjust notifications (email, SMS, etc.)

- **Menu> Settings > Sound & Display**.

Customize your email synchronization interval.

**Menu> Settings > Accounts & Sync > Exchange
ActiveSync
> Schedule.**

Placing and Receiving Calls

Placing calls

Tap **Phone** on the Home screen to open the Phone screen.

Tap the keys on the keypad to enter the phone number or the name of the contact you wish to dial.

Tap the **Call key** to place the call.

NOTE : If you tapped a wrong number, tap the **BACK** key to erase each subsequent digit of a number.

Receiving calls

To answer the call, tap **Answer** icon.

To reject the call, tap **Decline** icon .

Using Speakerphone and Mute

During a call, tap the Speakerphone icon or the Mute icon on the call screen to invoke the speaker or mute functions.

Helpful Hints – Quick List, Locking Phone and Email

The **Quick List** enables you to power off the phone and offers convenient access to a list of other functions, such as placing the device in Silent or Vibrate mode as well as placing the device in Airplane mode or turning on/off the Mobil Network data connections.

Note: The phone will enter Sleep mode in 10 seconds if you do not make a selection from the Quick List.

To access the Quick List

1. Press and hold the POWER button.
2. Select the desired option.
3. To exit the Quick List at any time, click **Home or Back Key**.

Locking your phone

Your phone automatically locks when one of the following occurs:

- The display is turned off and your phone goes to sleep mode.
- Your phone is password protected, and the set idle time has elapsed. Your phone locks itself and requires the correct password entry to unlock it.
- You can also lock the phone manually. While anywhere in the device short press the **POWER** key.

Using Email

After setting up email accounts on your device, you can start sending and receiving email messages.

Creating a new email message

1. On the Home screen, tap on the Mail icon.
2. Press Menu and select **Compose**.
4. To add recipients, enter their e-mail addresses or type their name. When the end user address appears, press the name to add to the "To" list.
5. Enter a subject and compose your message.

Tips

- To add an attachment to your message, tap **Menu > Add attachment**.

Choose attachment format and select the file to be attached.

- When finished composing the message, tap **Send**.

Helpful Hints – Bluetooth Technology

Bluetooth® Wireless Technology (v 2.1 w/ EDR)

The Droid Incredible supports Bluetooth wireless pairing. You can pair your smartphone with a Bluetooth stereo headphone, headsets or car kit. Bluetooth on your device operates in three different modes:

- * **On** - Bluetooth is turned on. Your device can detect other Bluetooth-enabled devices, but not vice versa.
- * **Discoverable** - Bluetooth is turned on, and all other Bluetooth-enabled devices can detect your device.
- **Off** - Bluetooth is turned off. In this mode, you can neither send nor receive information using Bluetooth.

To turn Bluetooth on and make your device visible

1. On your device, tap **Menu > Settings > Wireless & networks** and then tap **Bluetooth** to turn on or off. The icon will appear on the status bar. Under Bluetooth settings, press Discoverable to make the device discoverable for 2 min (120 seconds).




To Connect a Bluetooth hands-free or stereo headset

1. Make sure that both your device and the Bluetooth headset are turned on and within close range.
2. Tap the All Programs Icon > **Settings > Wireless & net works > Bluetooth Settings**.
3. Press **Scan for devices**.
4. Select the hands-free or stereo headset device in the list. Your device will automatically pair with the Bluetooth headset.

Note Your device will automatically try one of the preconfigured passcodes (0000, 8888) to pair with the Bluetooth headset. If this fails, you have to manually enter the pass code delivered with your headset.

5. When connected, the hands-free or stereo headset device is shown on the screen in the Bluetooth devices section with the pairing status of the device.

To create a Bluetooth partnership

1. Tap  > **Settings > Wireless & networks > Bluetooth Settings**.
2. Press **Scan for devices**.
3. Tap a Bluetooth device to connect with.
4. Specify a passcode, which can be 1 up to 16 characters, to establish a secure connection, and then tap **OK**.
5. After the receiving party accepts the partnership, the Bluetooth device name is shown on the screen.
6. The connected Bluetooth device now appears in the Bluetooth Devices list view on the Bluetooth Settings page.
